DAY 1

Arrival and transfers by taxi to our accommodation with water views. Time to settle in at our beautiful place where we can talk about our adventures to come in the following days. There will be a mix of photographers and non-photographers with professional cameras, iphones, GoPros and 360's. Whatever it is, this is the time to set it all up. Rita will be able to give you tips and editing ideas however, this is not a beginners photography course. You have to be able to use your gear and editing programs with confidence. Bring your lap-top or ipad to upload your wonderful photos, so we can all admire our wonderful heart-warming whale encounters.



DAY 2-9 / 2-10 / 2-11 / 2-12

After breakfast, we will be transferred to our whale charter boat. Spending a day on the water, looking for humpback whales and other marine life. There will be plenty of time to snorkel, explore remote caves and make the most of the tropical Pacific Ocean. A light lunch will be served on the boat, more whale sightings and then we will return to the accommodation for sunset drinks and dinner ala carte.



DAY 9 OR 10 OR 12

Sadly our last day... After breakfast, return transfers will be arranged to go to the airport.

Sundays are REST days. No one in Tonga is allowed to work unless you're at a private resort / home stay. We will have a day to just do nothing, explore the island. I can highly recommend going to the local church to let the singing vibrate through your body just like the whale songs.



GROUP SIZE

Minimum of 5 guests per group required. Max. of 6 guests per group.
